Delivering Under Pressure: Time-Critical Aluminum Can Decorator Machine Transport to Saudi Arabia

A U.K.-based client required the urgent transport of an Aluminum Can Decorator Machine from Centennial, Colorado, USA, to Dammam, Saudi Arabia. The high-value equipment, measuring 5.9 meters in length, 2.54 meters in width, and 4 meters in height, weighed 16-tons and carried a price tag of \$1.3 million.

With a strict production schedule driving the timeline, the machine needed to arrive at its destination within 16 days. Given its oversized dimensions and specialized handling requirements, a seamless logistics strategy was critical to ensuring safe and on-time delivery.

To meet the tight deadline, the logistics team secured a reliable carrier that could accommodate the cargo's oversized height while optimizing the route for efficiency. Specialized handling procedures were implemented to ensure the machine's safe transport.

Securement & Handling

The machine was carefully loaded onto a flat rack using heavy-duty cranes and lifting straps. Custom restraints were applied to prevent movement and mitigate the risk of damage.

Tailored Transport Planning

A vessel was strategically selected to ensure proper accommodations for the machine's height while maintaining the required transit time.
