Multi-Month Transport Program Delivered Oversized Units to Data Center

OVERVIEW

Green Worldwide Shipping® (Green) coordinated the transport of more than 80 oversized industrial units from Indiana to Utah over a four- to six-month period. Each shipment measured at least 390" × 93" × 111" and weighed approximately 12,000 lbs. The program required precision execution of repeat shipments to keep pace with project construction milestones at the destination data center.

SOLUTION

Green selected step deck Conestoga trailers to provide both clearance for the oversized skids and consistent enclosure during transit. This minimized exposure while maintaining standardized handling across all shipments. Comprehensive route surveys were conducted between Indiana and Utah to ensure compliance with oversize transport regulations. Green coordinated with carriers and site operators to manage arrivals in sequence, preventing congestion and ensuring the project schedule remained uninterrupted.
