Breakbulk Project Delivered Drilling Equipment to Ghana

OVERVIEW

Green Worldwide Shipping® (Green) managed the export of oversized drilling equipment from Houston and Freeport, Texas to Ghana to support ongoing drilling operations. The cargo included derricks, CAT engines, mud pits, a drill rig substructure, a Kelly drive bushing, and a complete Wilson 42B-500 drilling rig unit. The two breakbulk shipments weighed more than 176,000 pounds combined and required heavy lift handling and coordinated port operations to prepare the cargo for ocean transport.

SOLUTION

Green managed export logistics for both shipments, aligning inland collection, port delivery, and vessel scheduling across the two origin points. Oversized drilling components were prepared for breakbulk handling and positioned using specialized lifting equipment to ensure safe loading. Coordinated cargo sequencing and port oversight ensured each unit moved efficiently through export operations and onto the vessel bound for Ghana.

Multi-Origin Coordination

Equipment originating from Houston and Freeport required synchronized inland movement and port delivery to align with vessel loading schedules.

Heavy Lift Handling

Large drilling components were lifted and positioned using specialized equipment designed for oversized cargo.

Breakbulk Vessel Loading

Each unit was prepared and staged for breakbulk ocean transport to support secure loading and stable positioning during transit.

Export Execution

Coordinated port operations and cargo sequencing ensured efficient handling from origin through departure.
